Pat is predeceased by her loving husband James Groover and her brother Walter F. Ennis, Jr. and her parents Walter and Margaret Ennis.

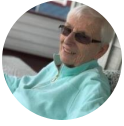
She is survived by her daughters Noreen Lape of Mechanicsburg, PA and Erin Groover of Lake Hiawatha, NJ.
